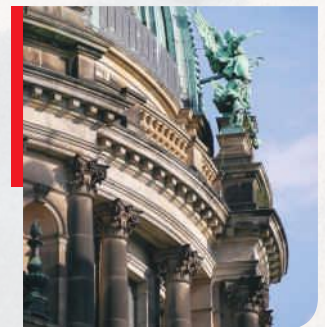

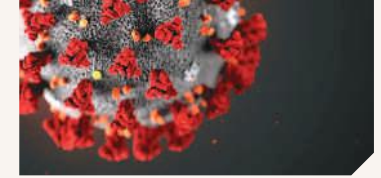

Zambia has been endorsed with a safety stamp by the World Travel and Tourism Council (WTTC) for international travel

Q1

Do I need to have a COVID-19 Negative Test Certificate when I travel to Zambia?

ANS: Yes, a SARS CoV2 PCR Test

Q2

How long should the Negative COVID-19 PCR Test be valid for?

ANS: 72 Hours. Passengers travelling to Zambia must present a negative COVID-19 PCR test certificate conducted within 72 hours. Also, check with your carrier for COVID-19 travel requirements as they may be different.

Q3

Will I be tested for COVID-19 upon arrival at the airport?

ANS: Health authorities conduct random checks on arriving passengers and those found with temperatures above 38 °C will be subjected to further screening despite being in possession of a negative result. If found positive, then the COVID-19 National Case Management will be followed.

Q4

Will I be Quarantined upon arrival into Zambia?

ANS: No. Routinely, you will be required to monitor yourself in the next 14 days for any COVID-19 related symptoms and report any occurrence to the nearest health facility.

Q5

Which Airlines are flying to Zambia during this COVID-19 Pandemic?

ANS: Foreign Airlines - SA Airlink, Emirates, Kenya Airways, Ethiopian Airlines and Air Tanzania.
Domestic Airlines - Proflight Zambia, Mahogany Air and Royal Zambezi Airlines.

Q6

Where can I get tested for COVID-19?

ANS: PCR tests are available at all Government Provincial Hospitals in urban centres such as Lusaka, Livingstone and Ndola. The tests are also available from private hospitals, see attached list with details. The service is available at a fee.

Q7

Do I need a Medical Travel Certificate when returning to my country after visiting Zambia?

ANS: You may, depending on the requirements by either the airlines or destination of disembarkation, check the details before departure for your convenience.

Q8

Does the tourism sector in Zambia have COVID-19 safety protocols in place?

Ans: The industry is guided by the official Tourism COVID-19 Safety Protocols, these are available online via www.zambia.travel

Q9

Does the Covid-19 safety protocols been recognized internationally?

ANS: Yes Zambia has been endorsed with a safety stamp by the World Travel and Tourism Council (WTTC) for international travel.
